

A self-funder is someone who **pays the full cost for any care & support services** they receive from the council or from an independent provider



You may be a self-funder if you have savings **over £23,250**



Or you **own** your own home or any other **property**



Or you **don't want** a financial assessment



Or you want to arrange your care **yourself**

Can I still get help from the Council if I am a **self-funder**?



We can help you to have care in your **own home**.



Give you **information** about local services



Help you find a **personal assistant** or care agency

Help you to write a **support plan**



Help you **review** your support plan each year



Help you **arrange payments** for your care



Do a **financial assessment** with you if you need one
