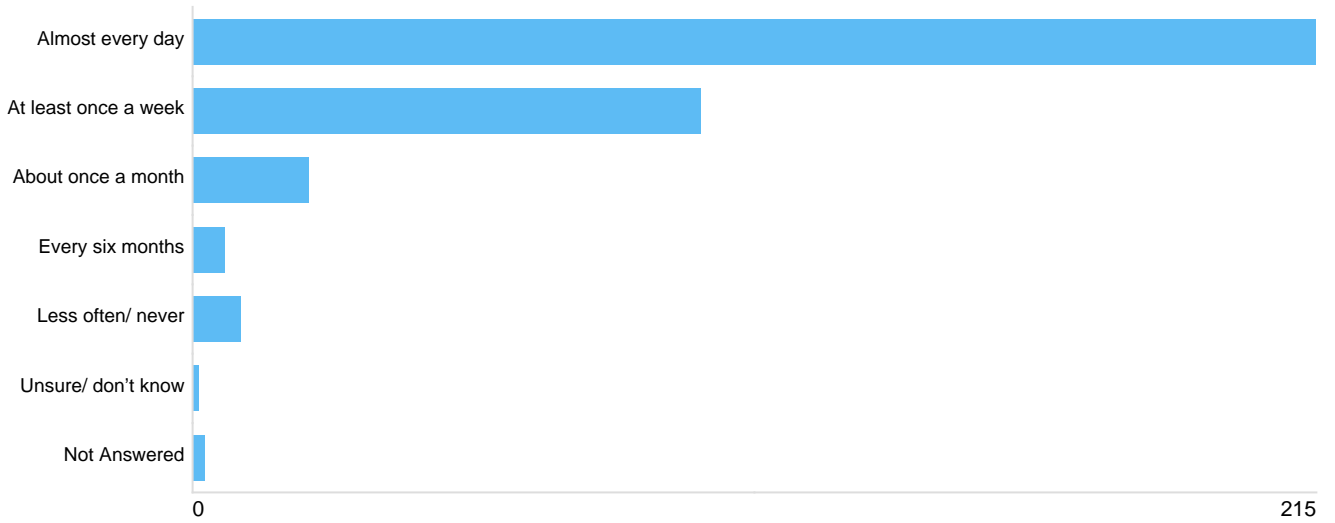

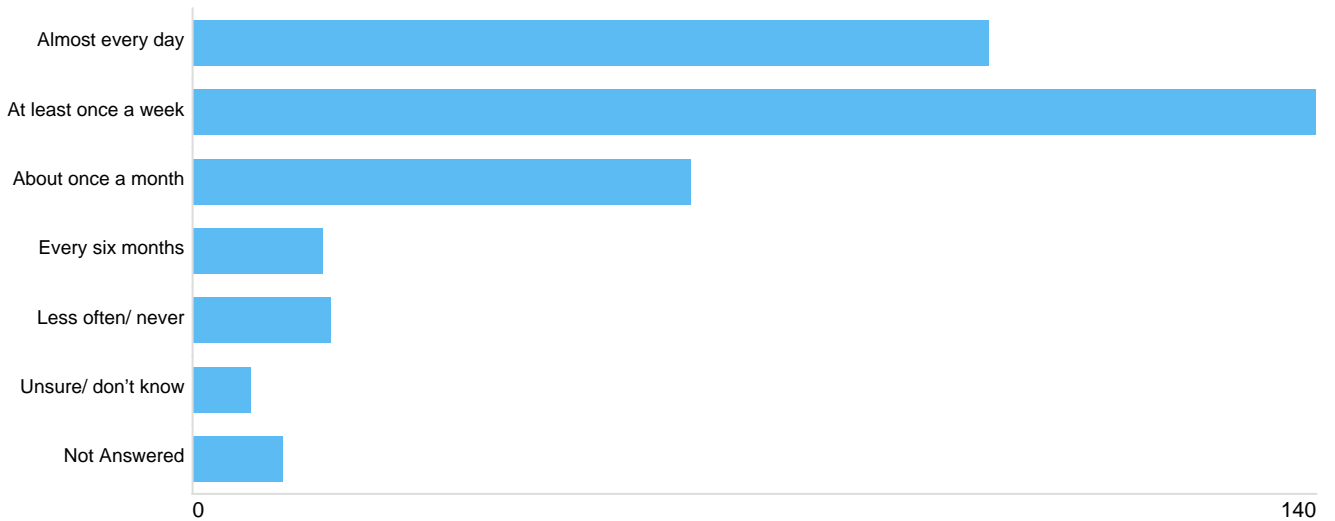

Frequency of use - Parks, gardens and other green space



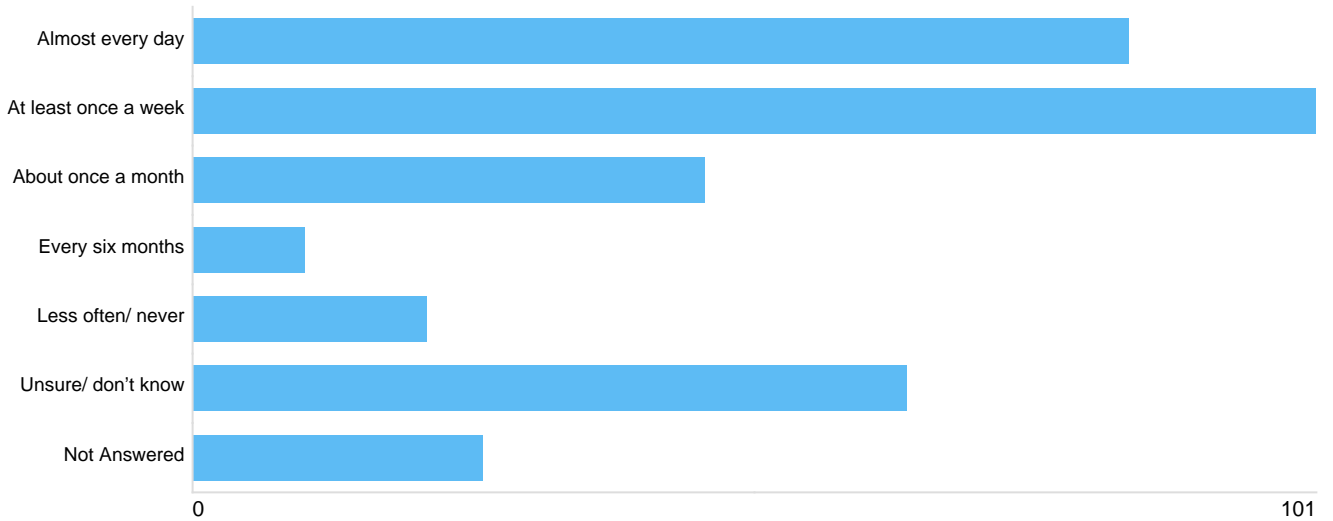

Frequency of use - Semi-natural green space and country parks



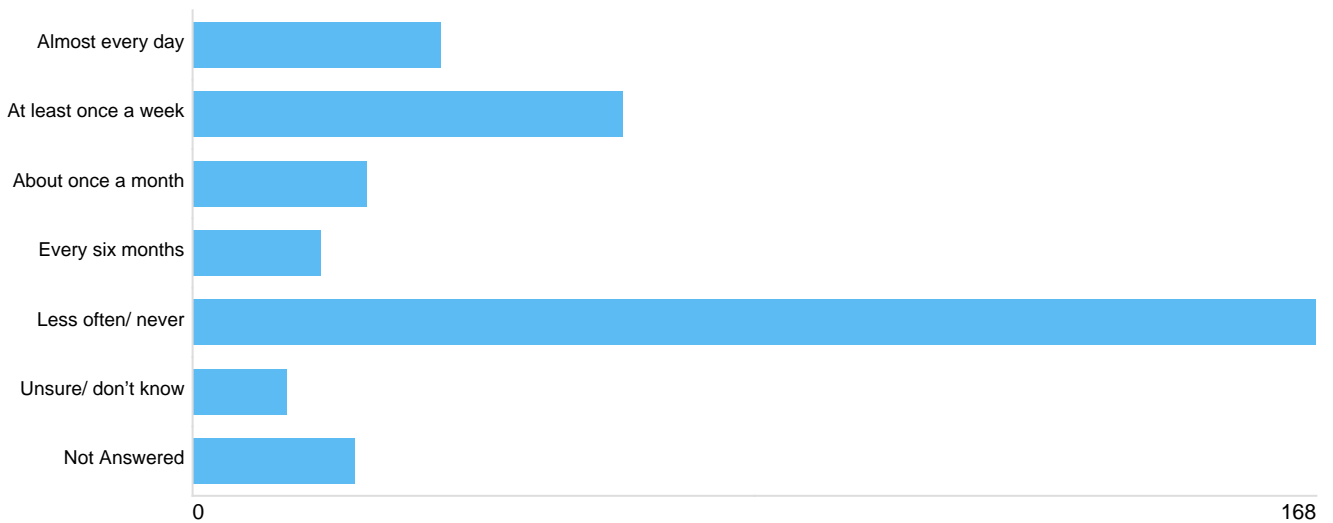

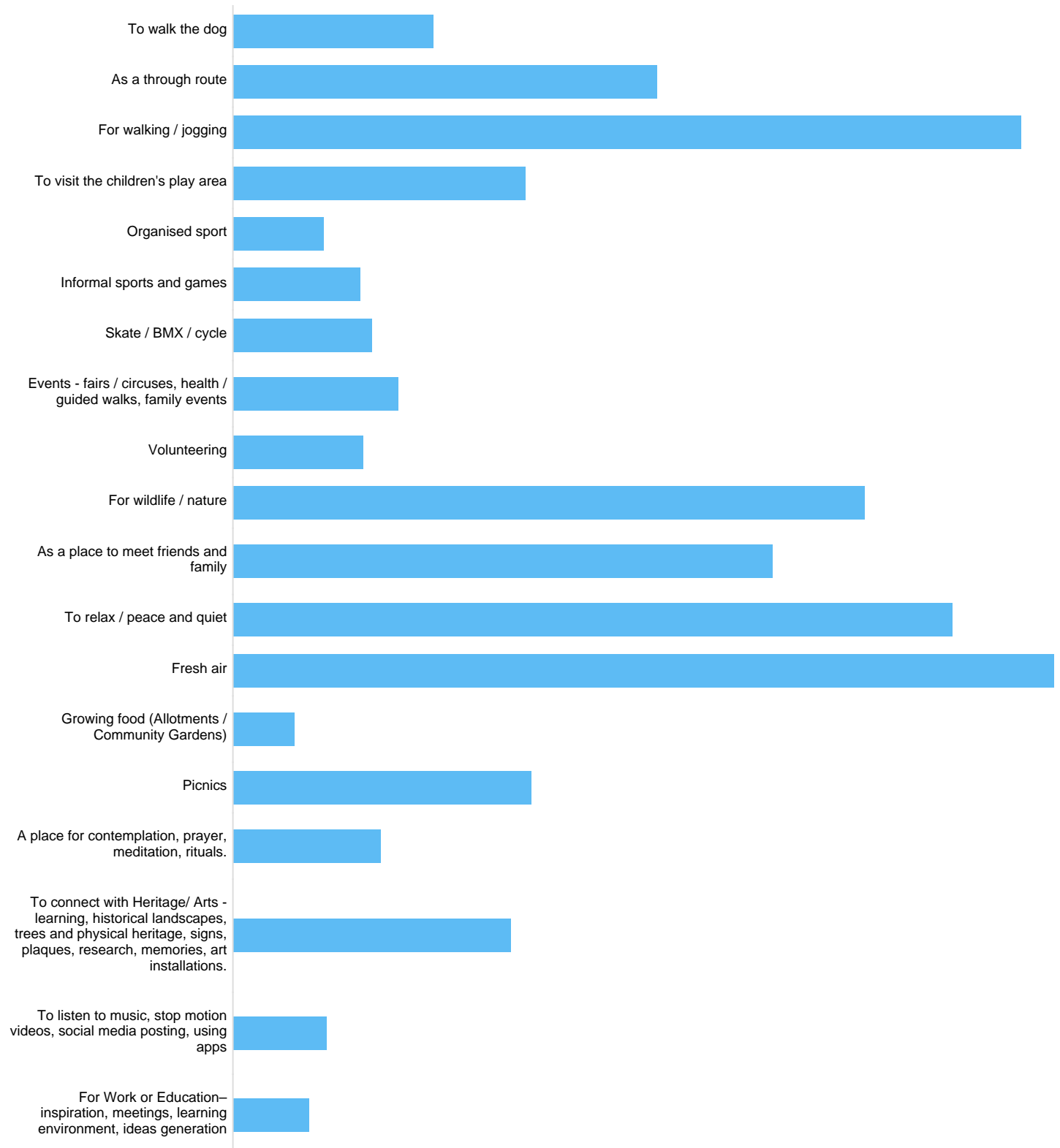

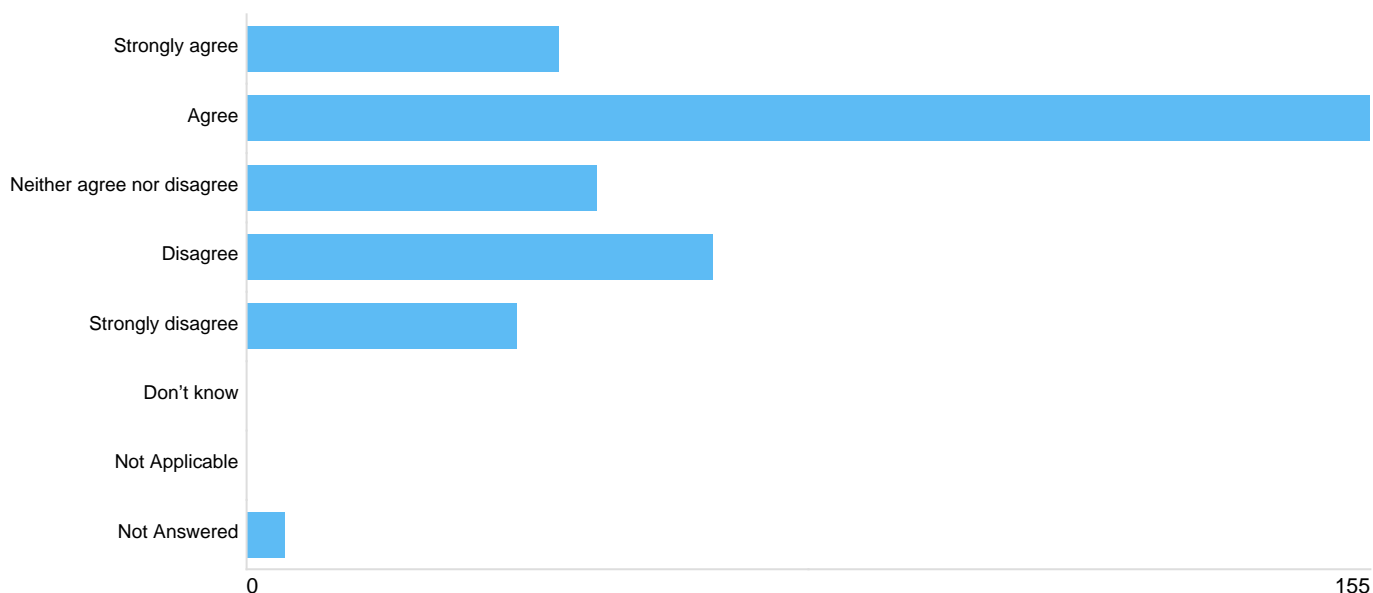

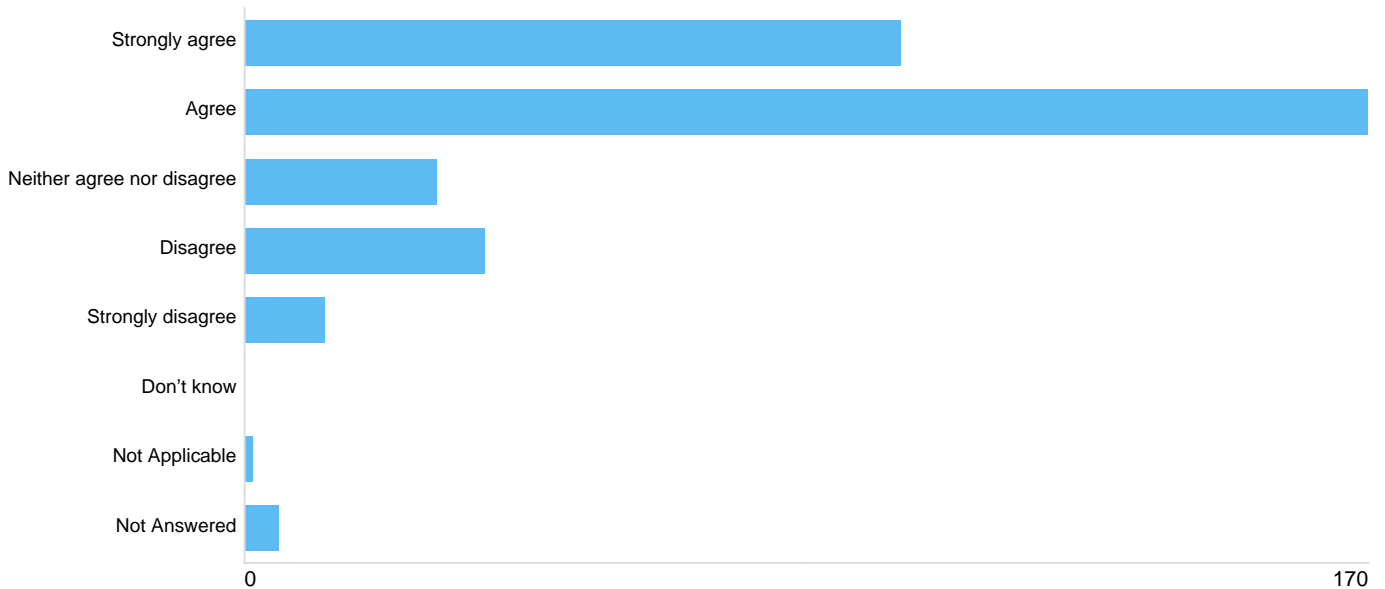

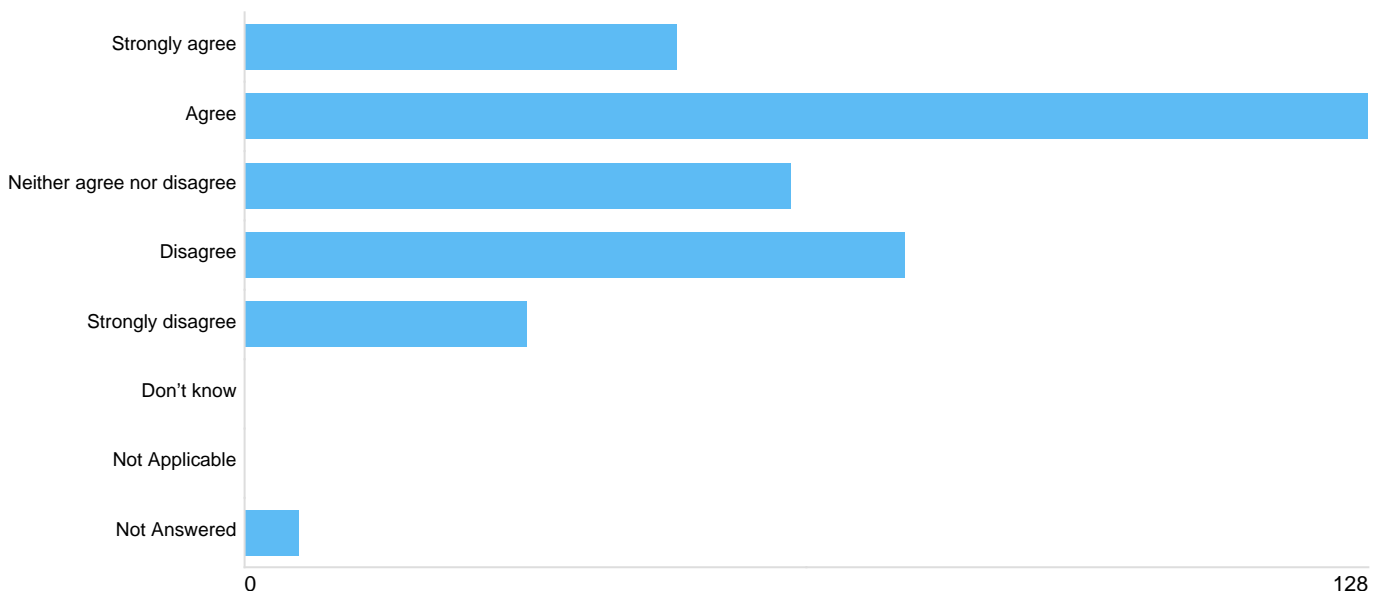

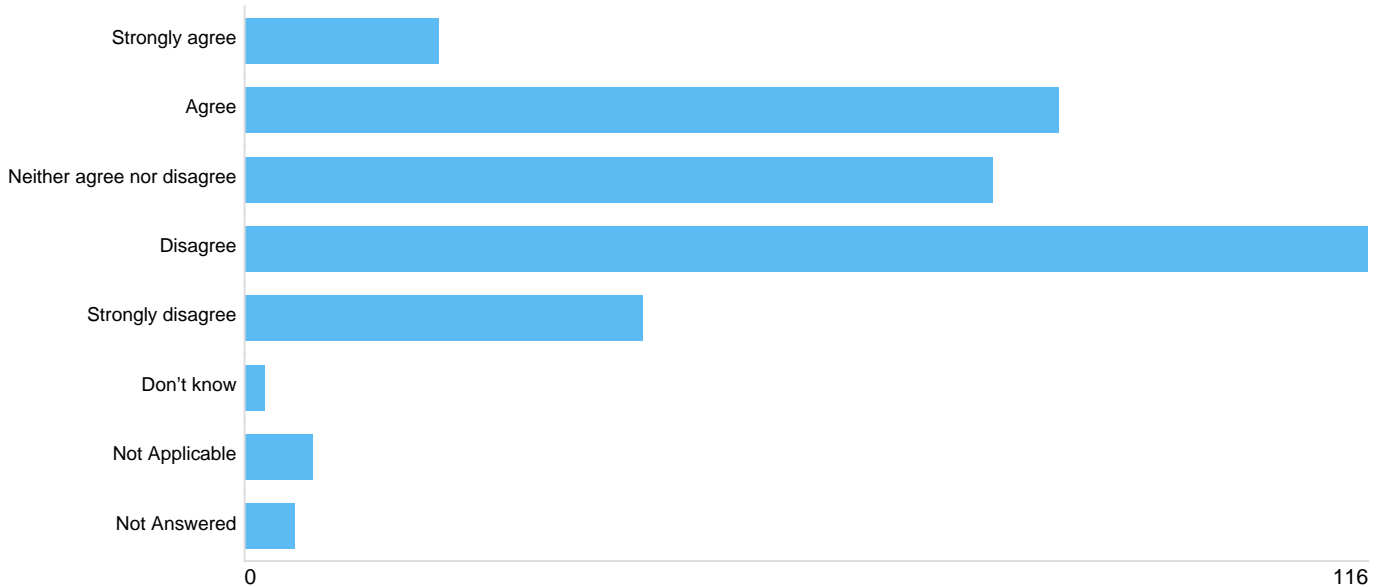

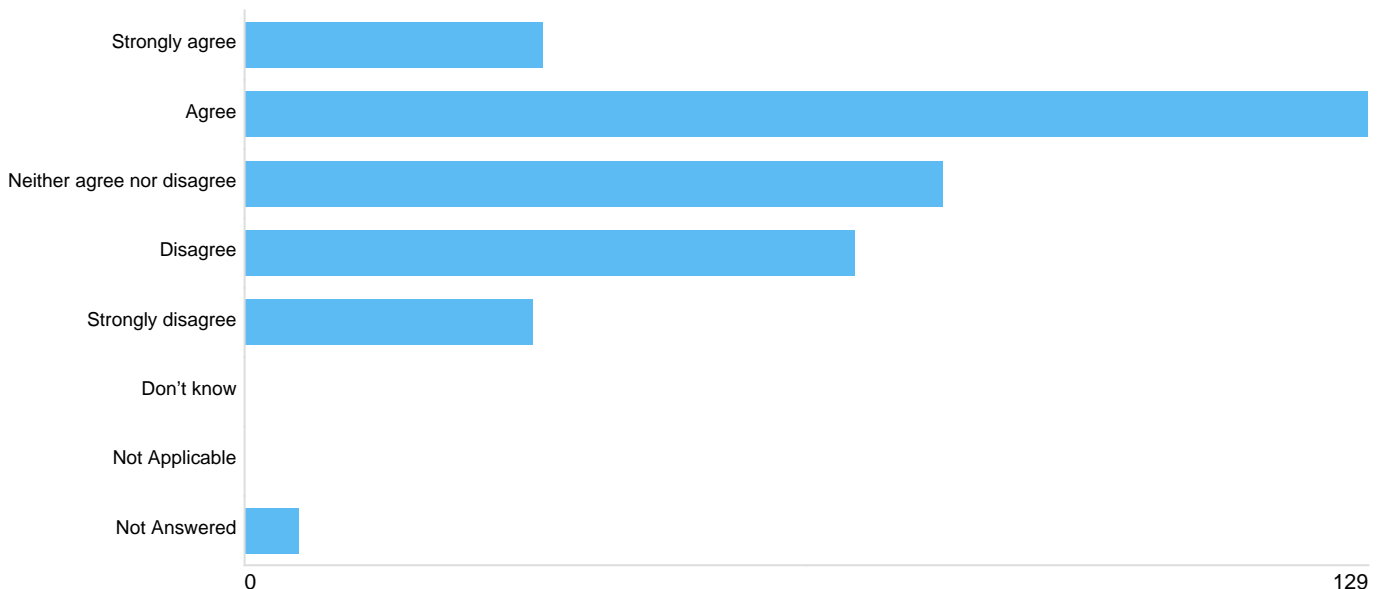

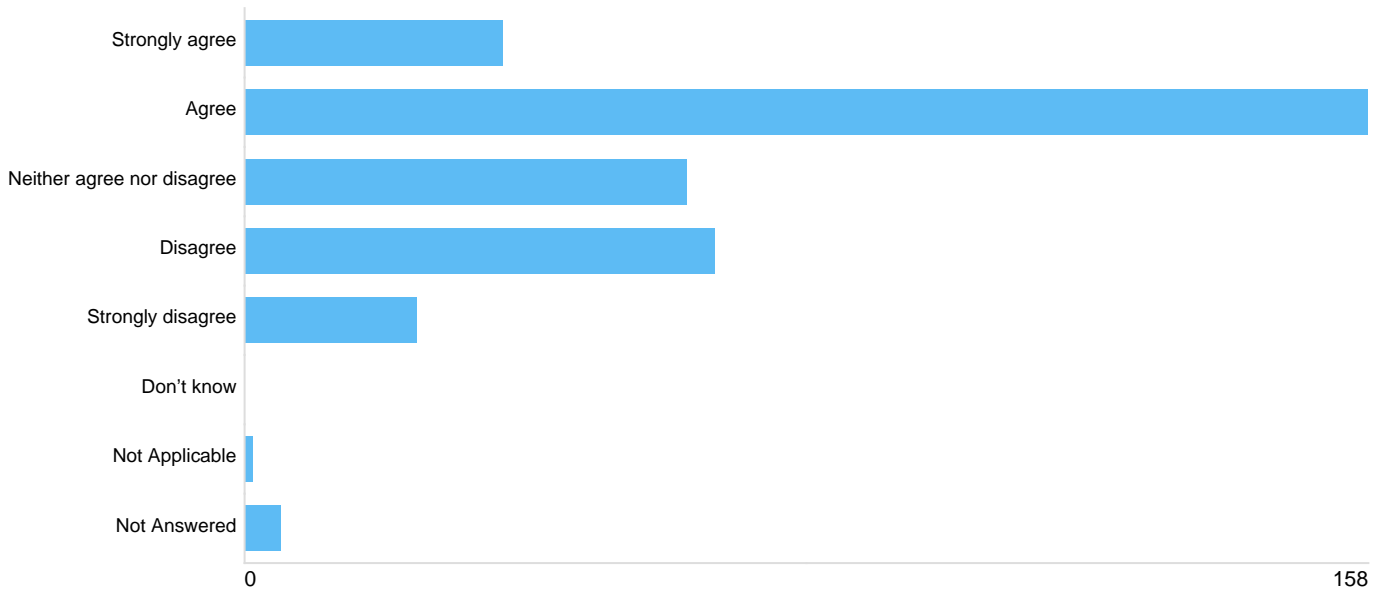

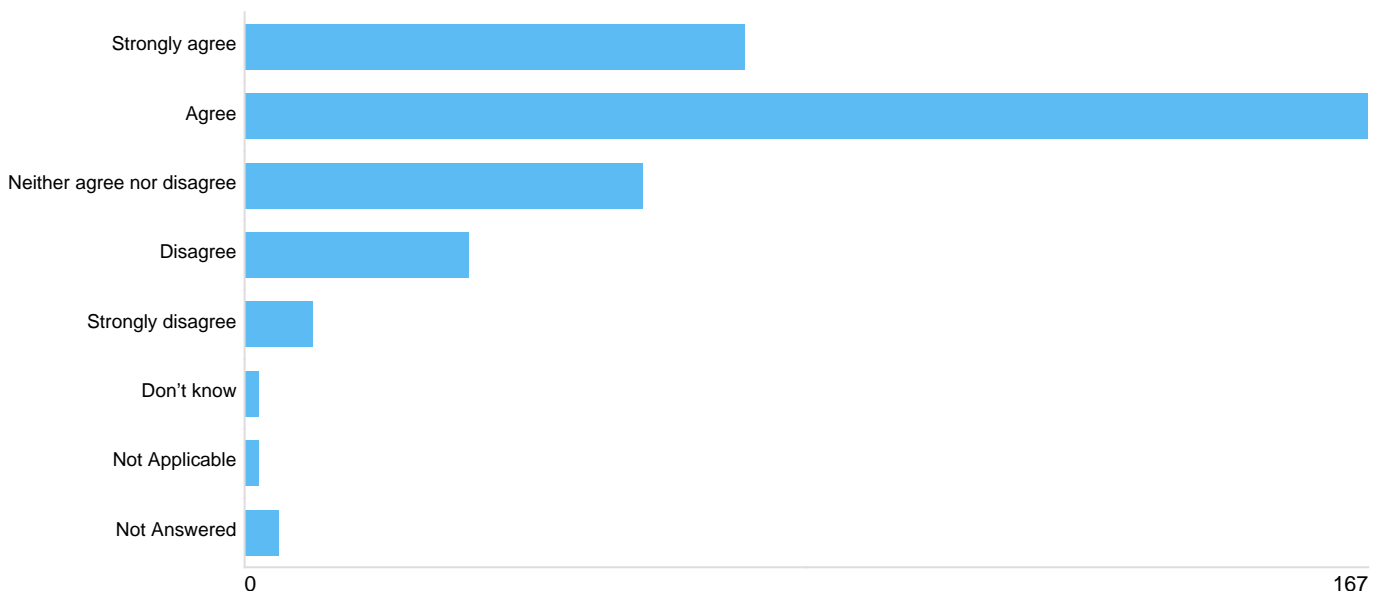

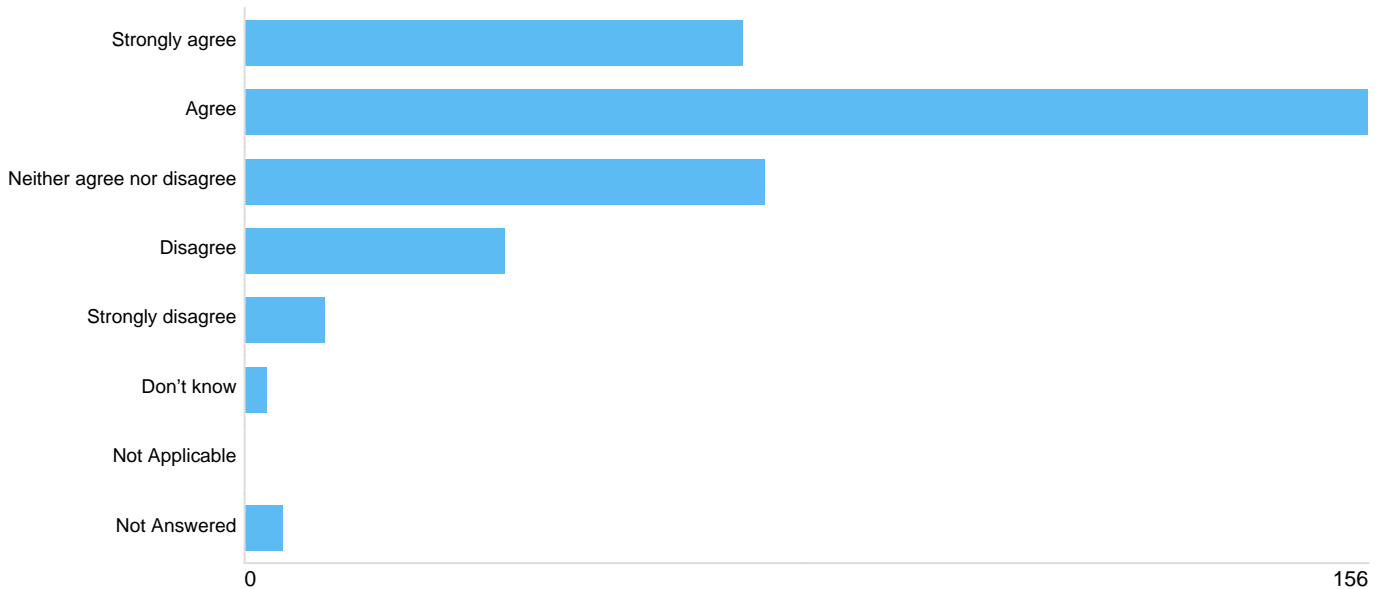

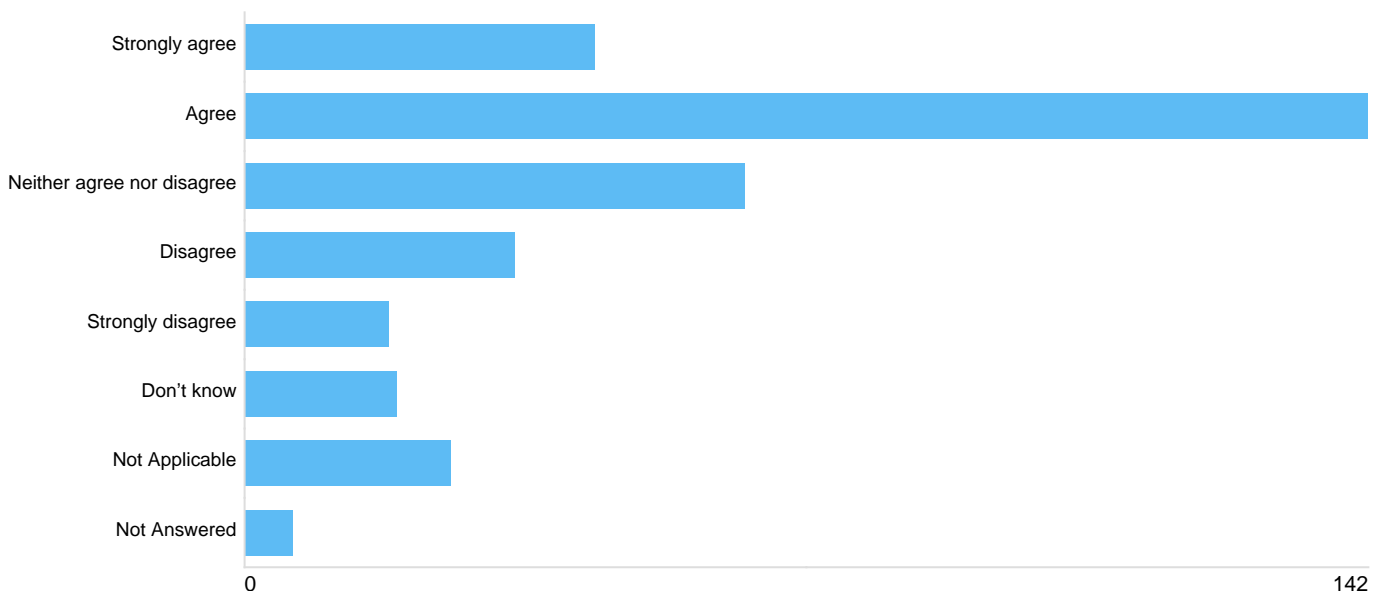

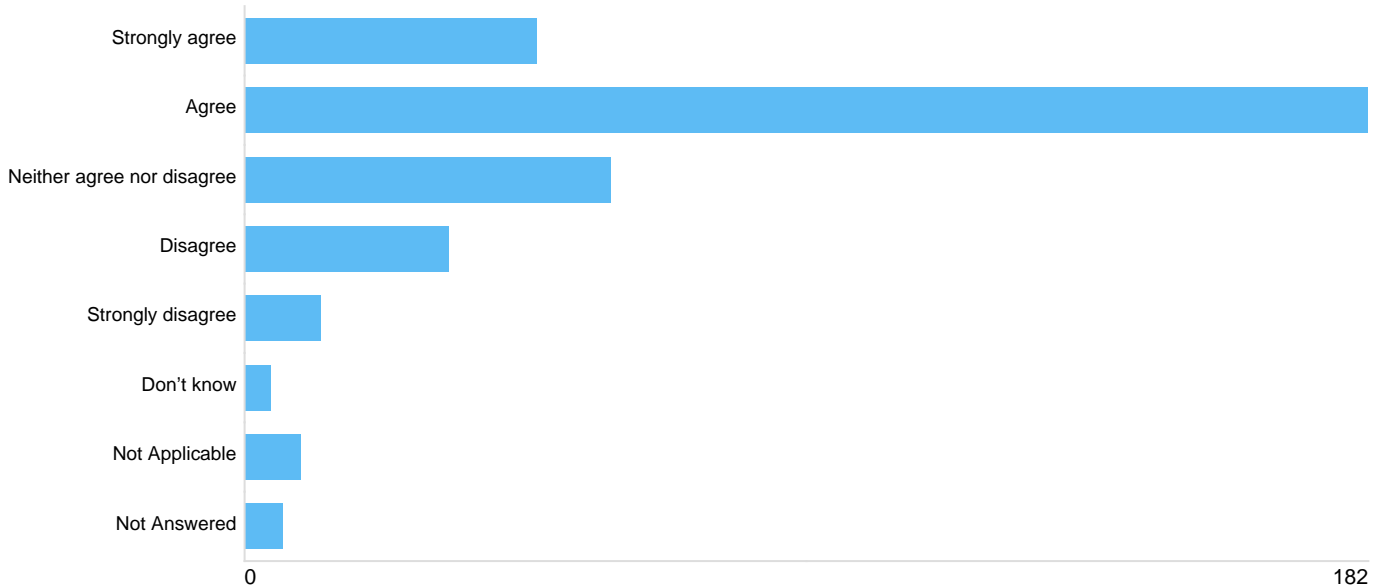

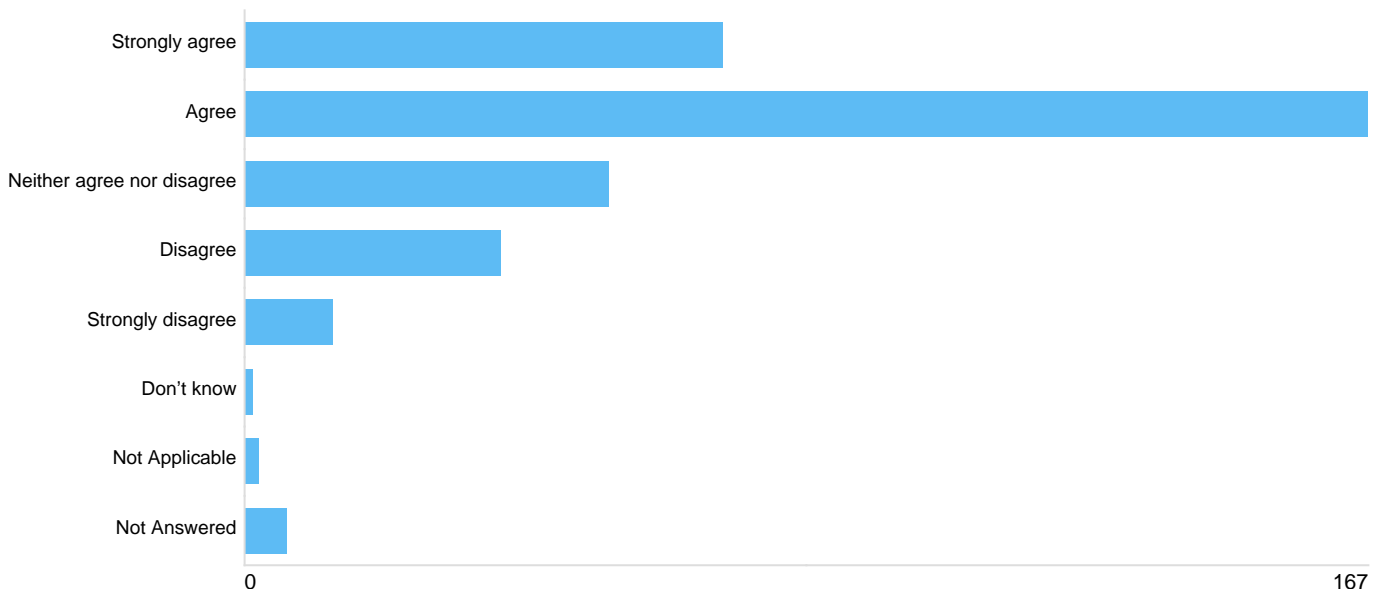

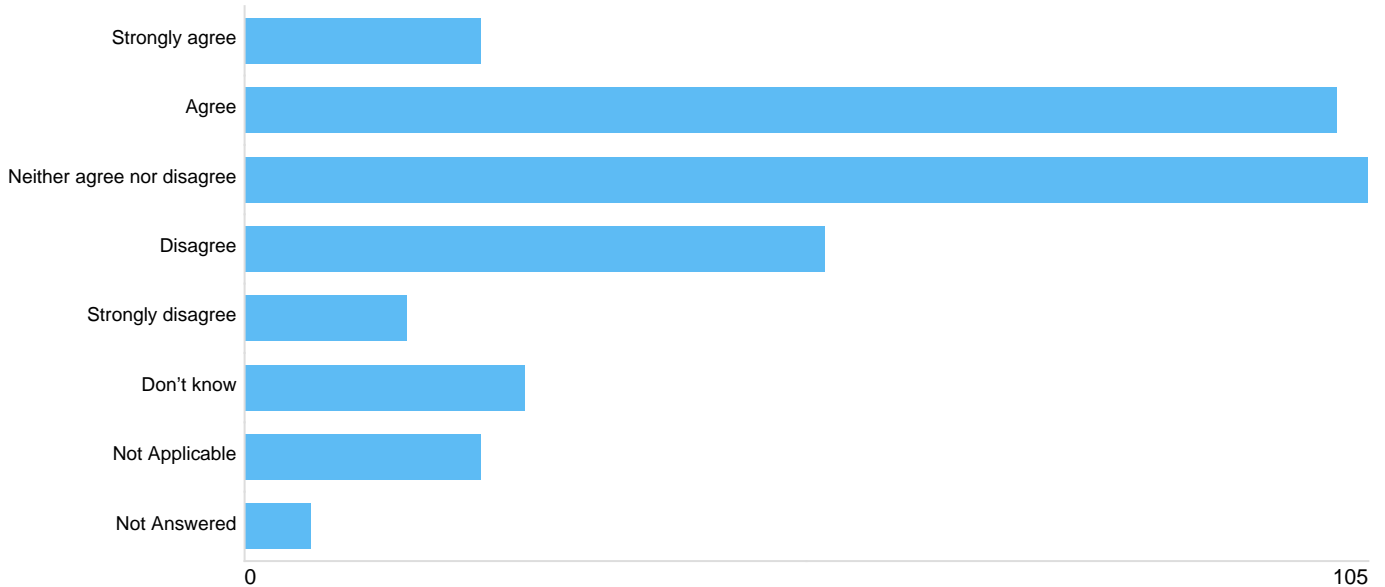

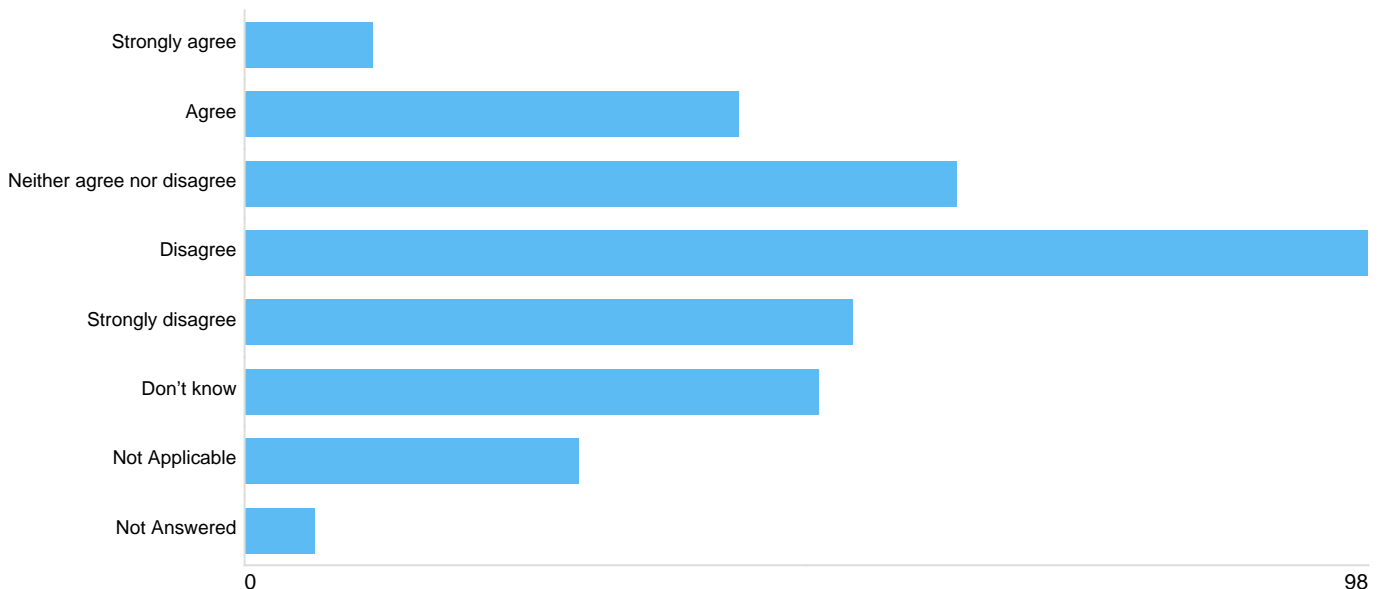

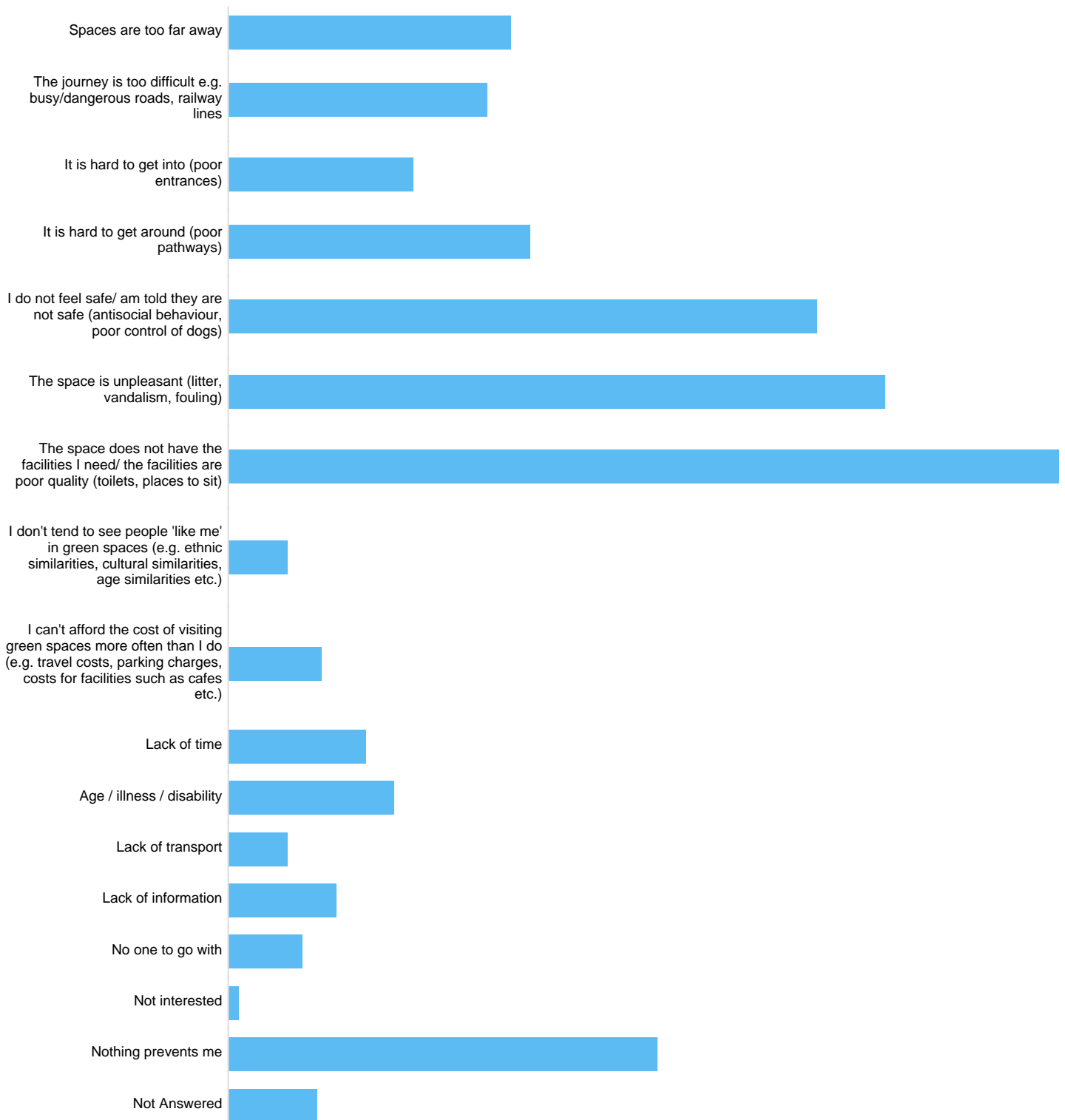

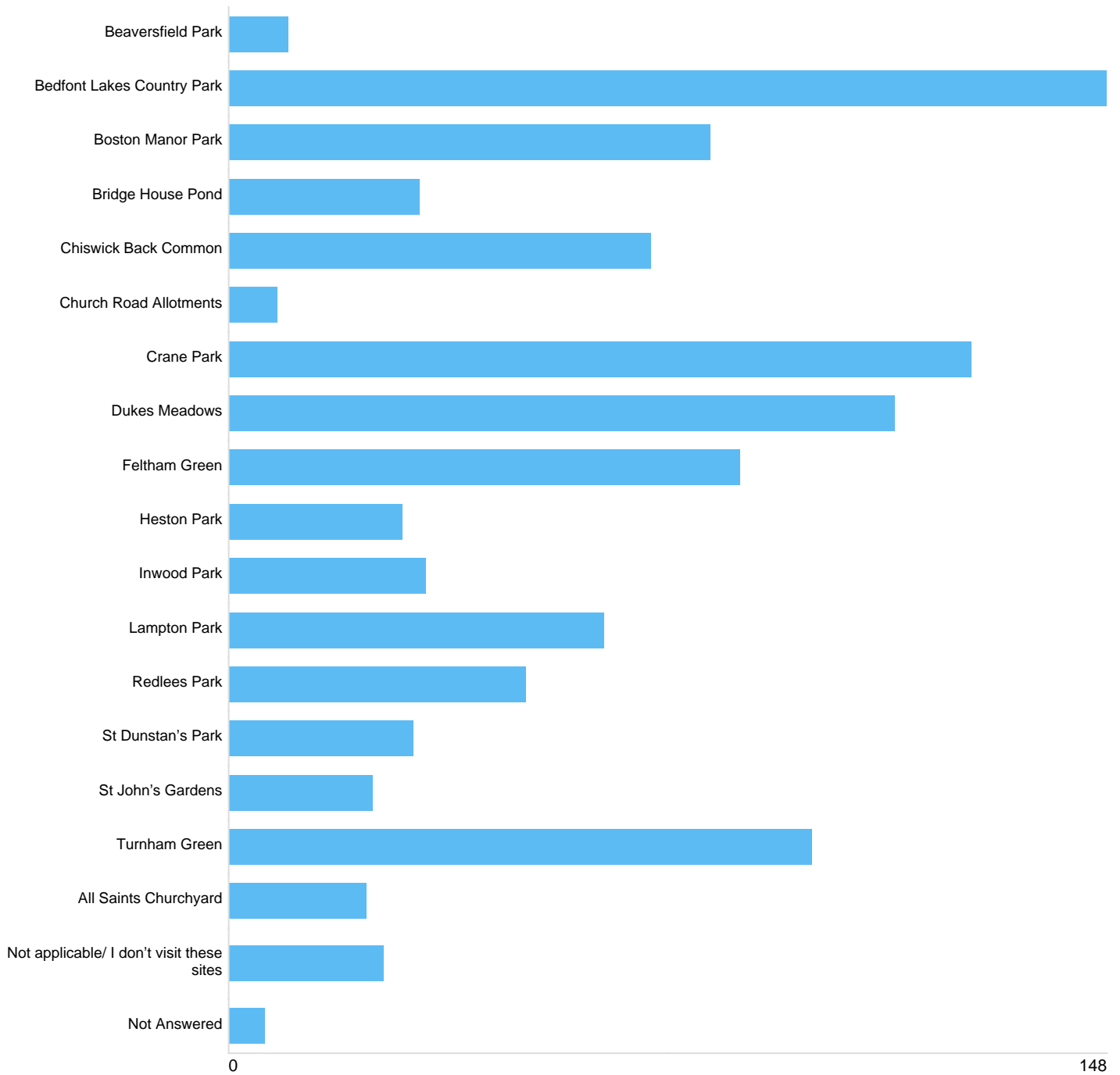

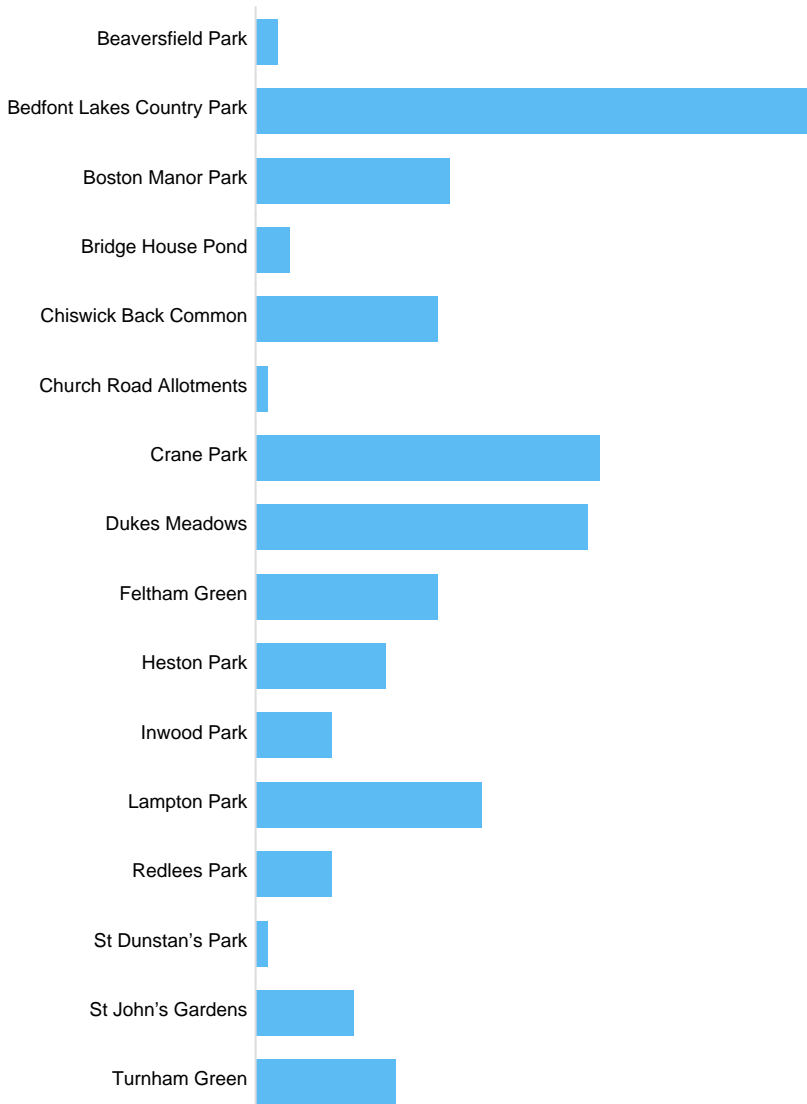

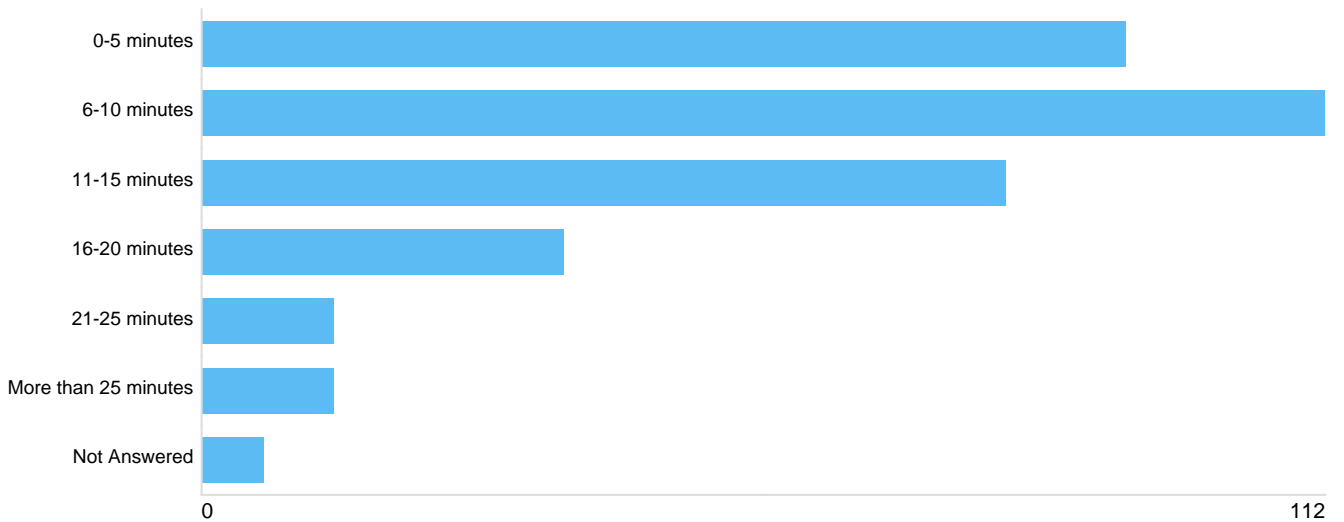

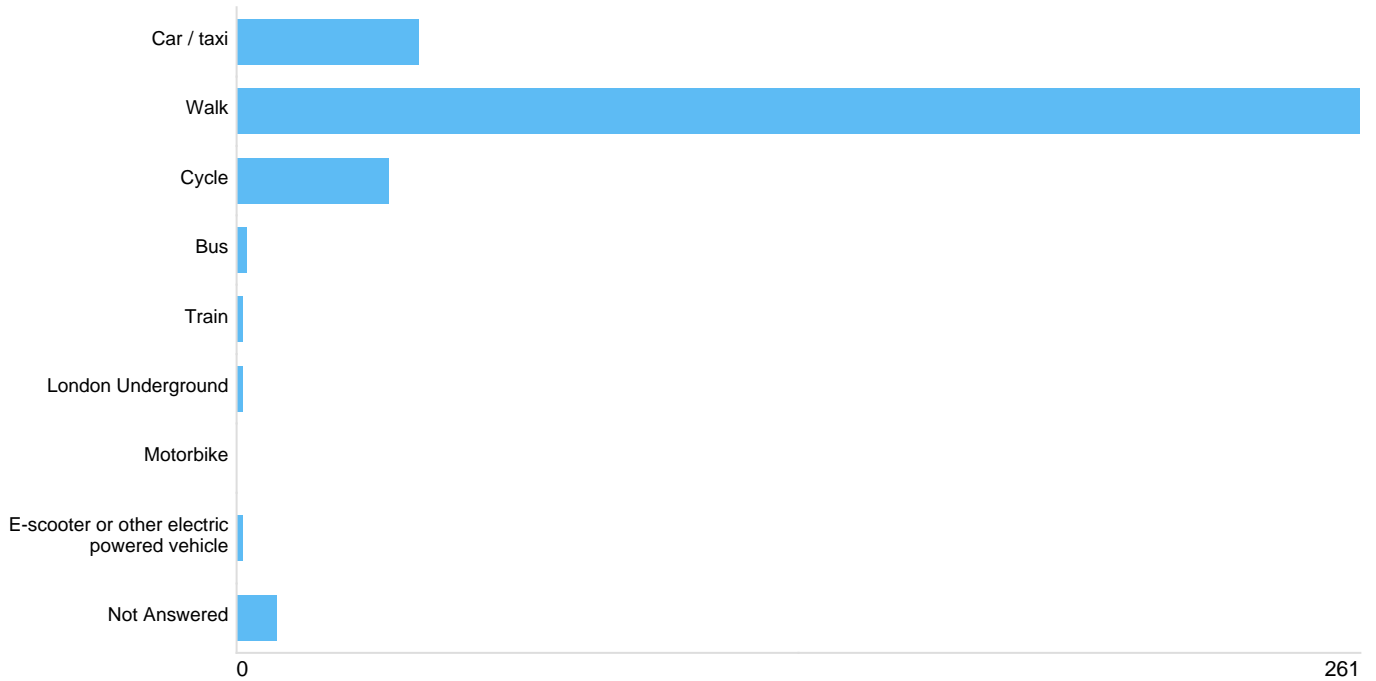

Travel mode



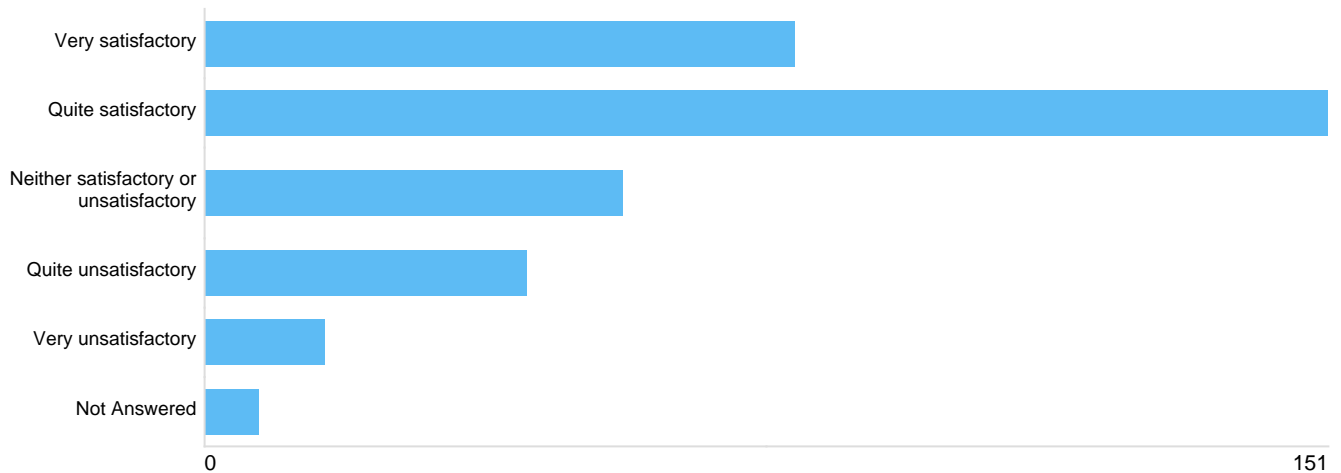

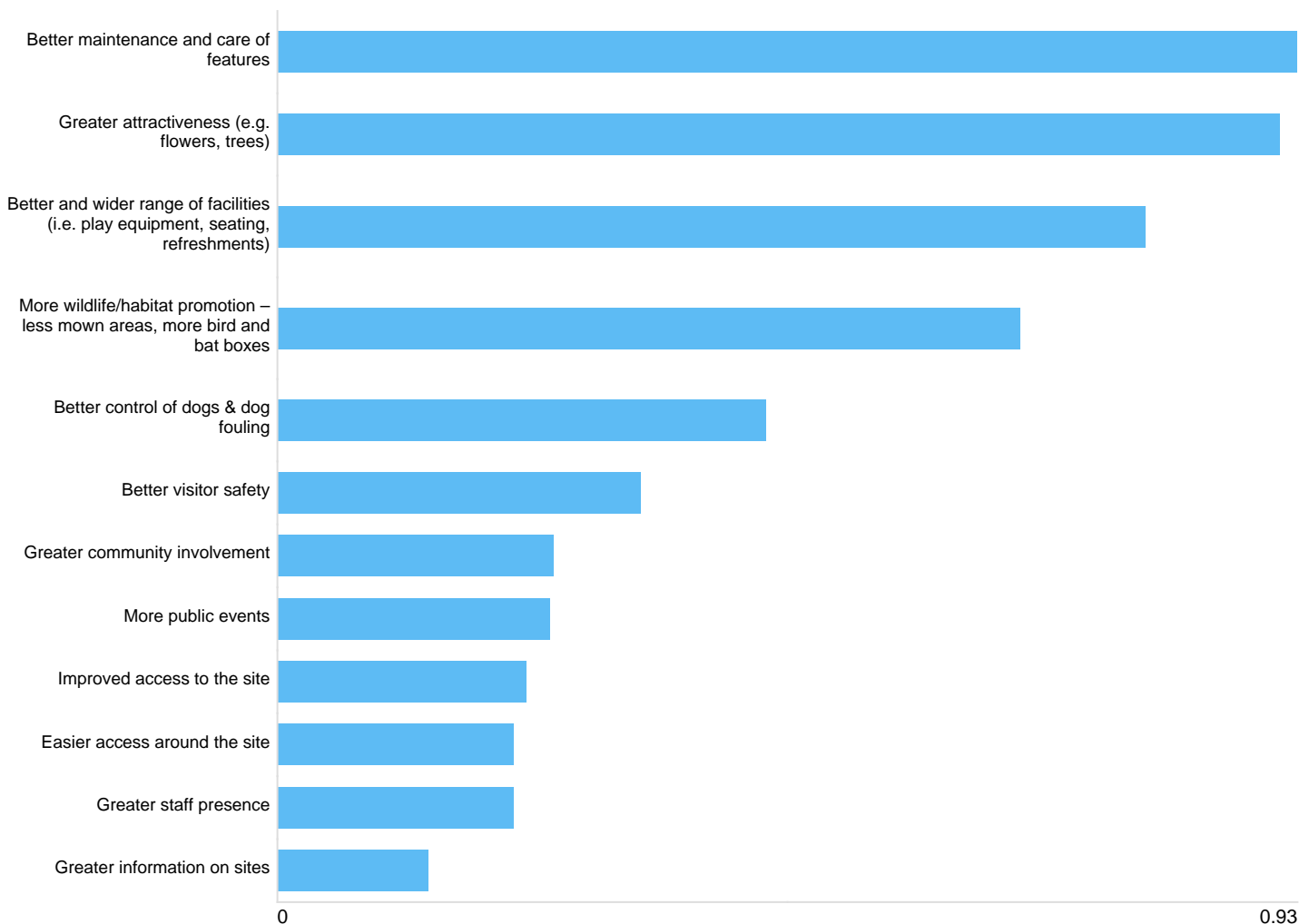

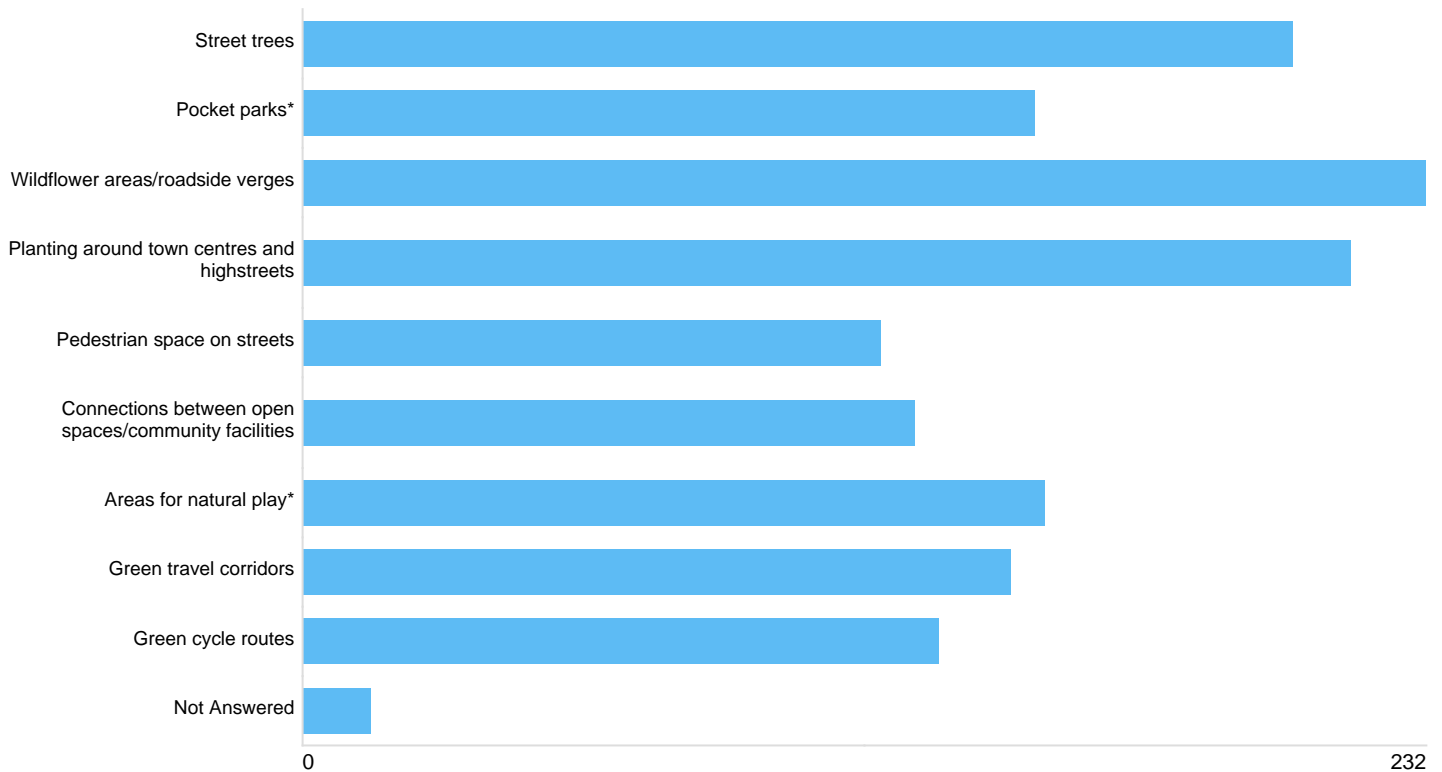

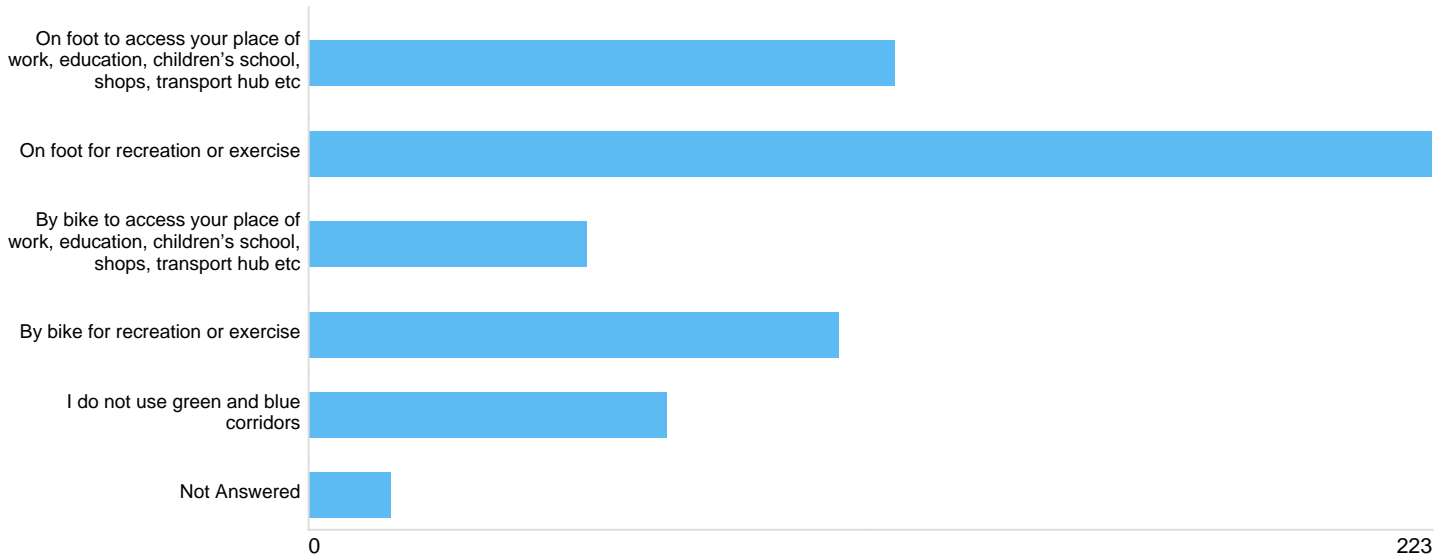

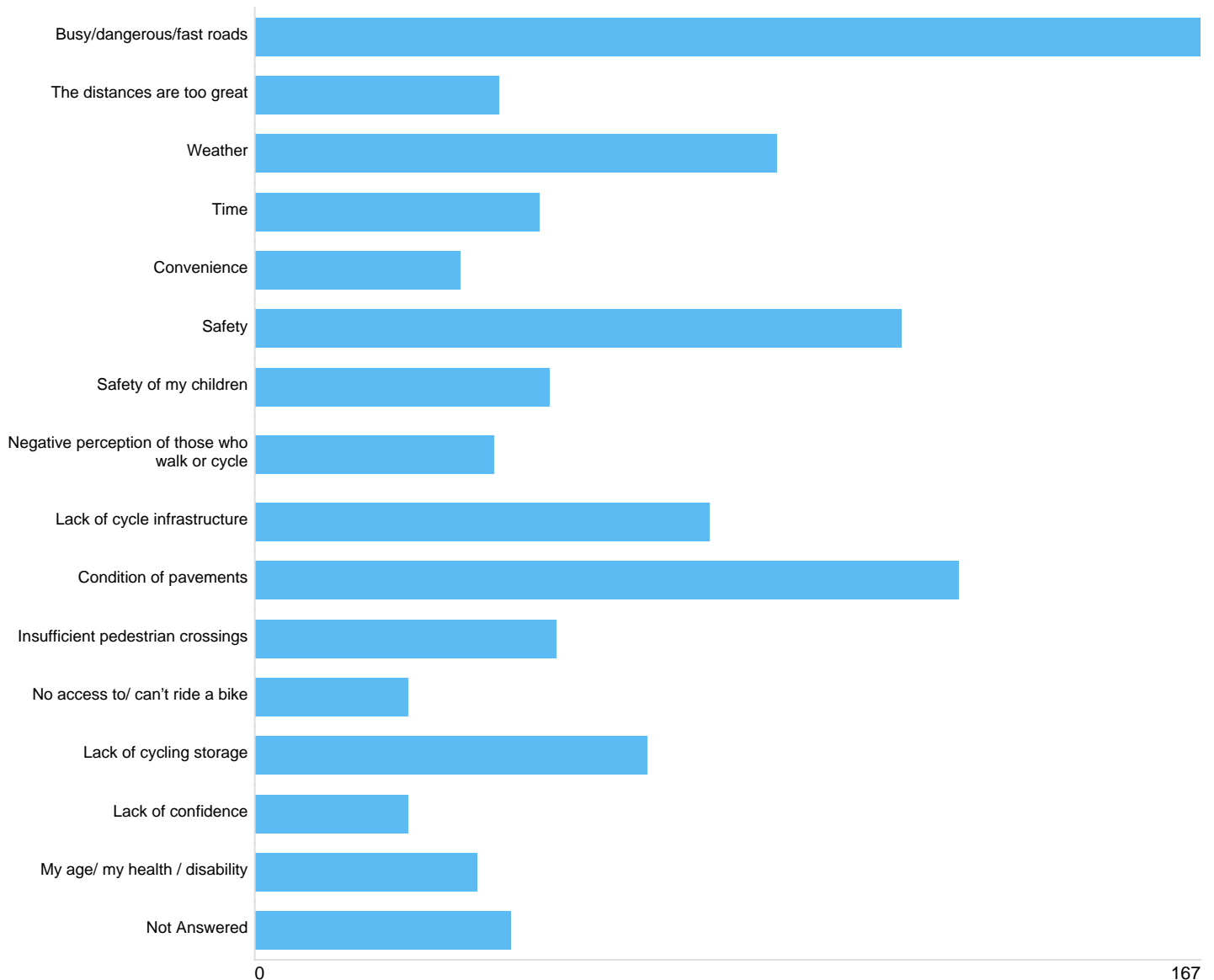

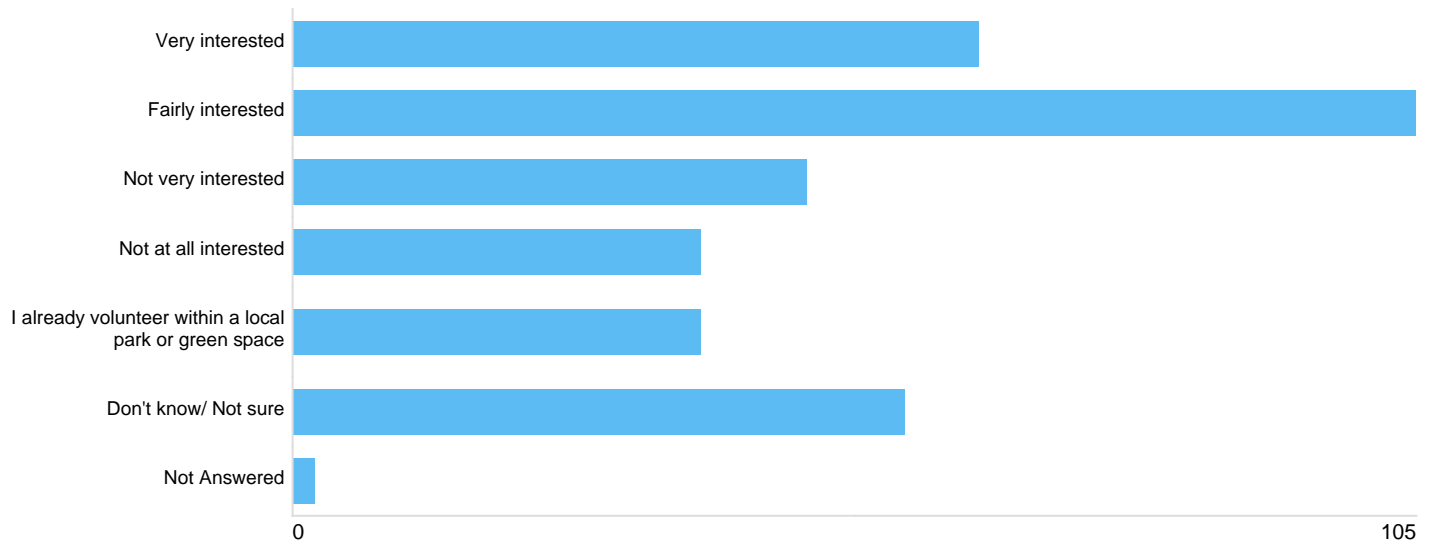

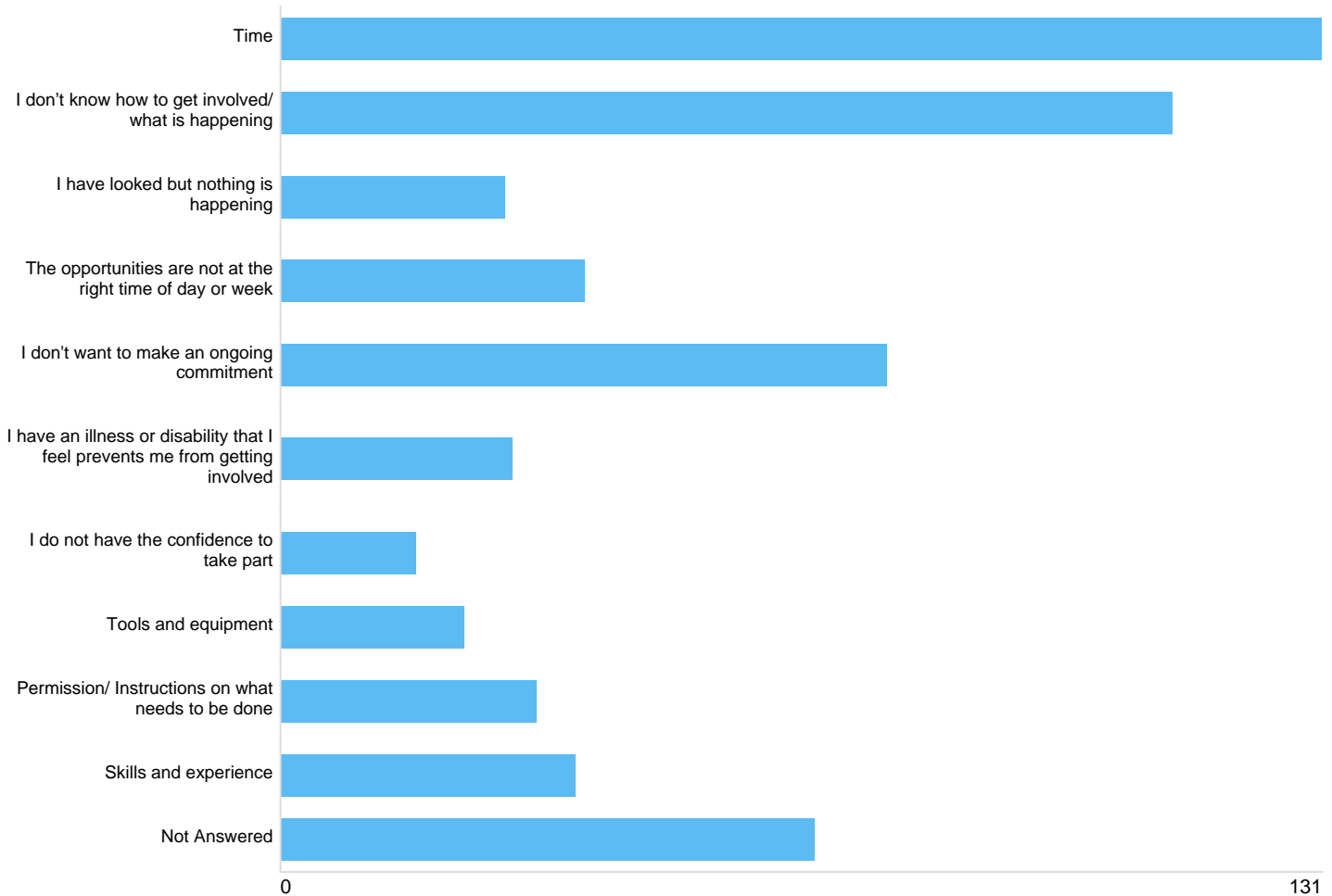

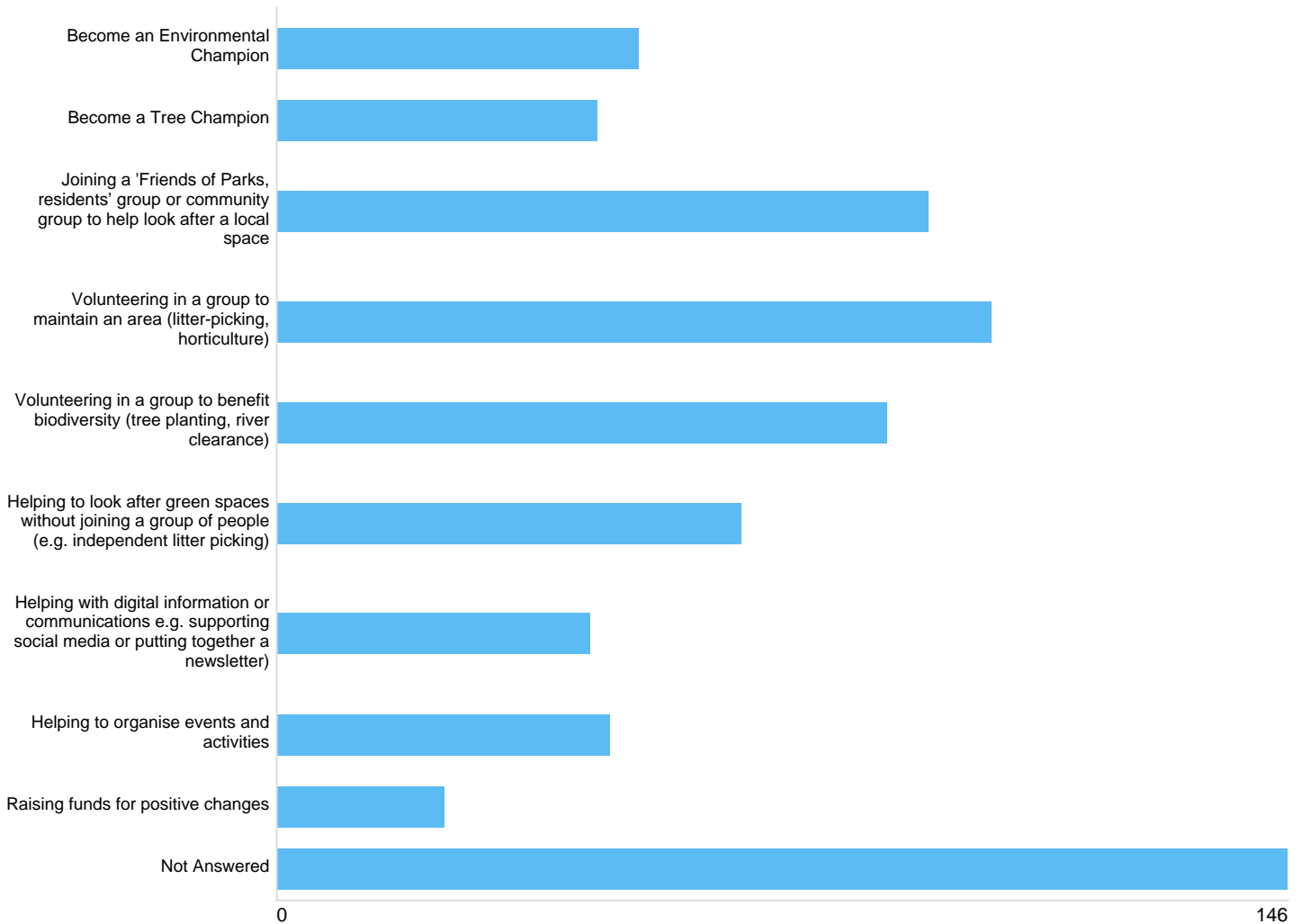

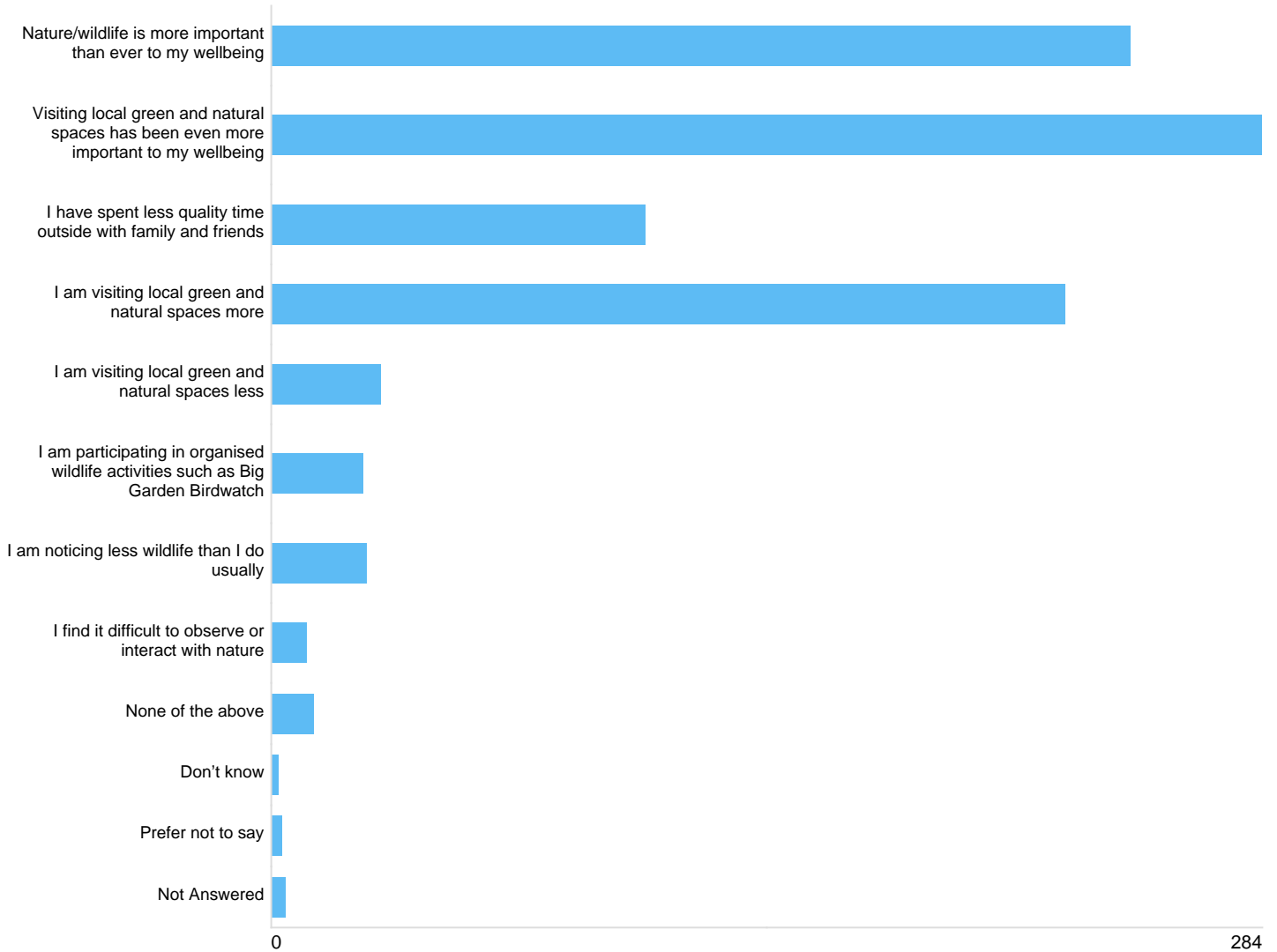

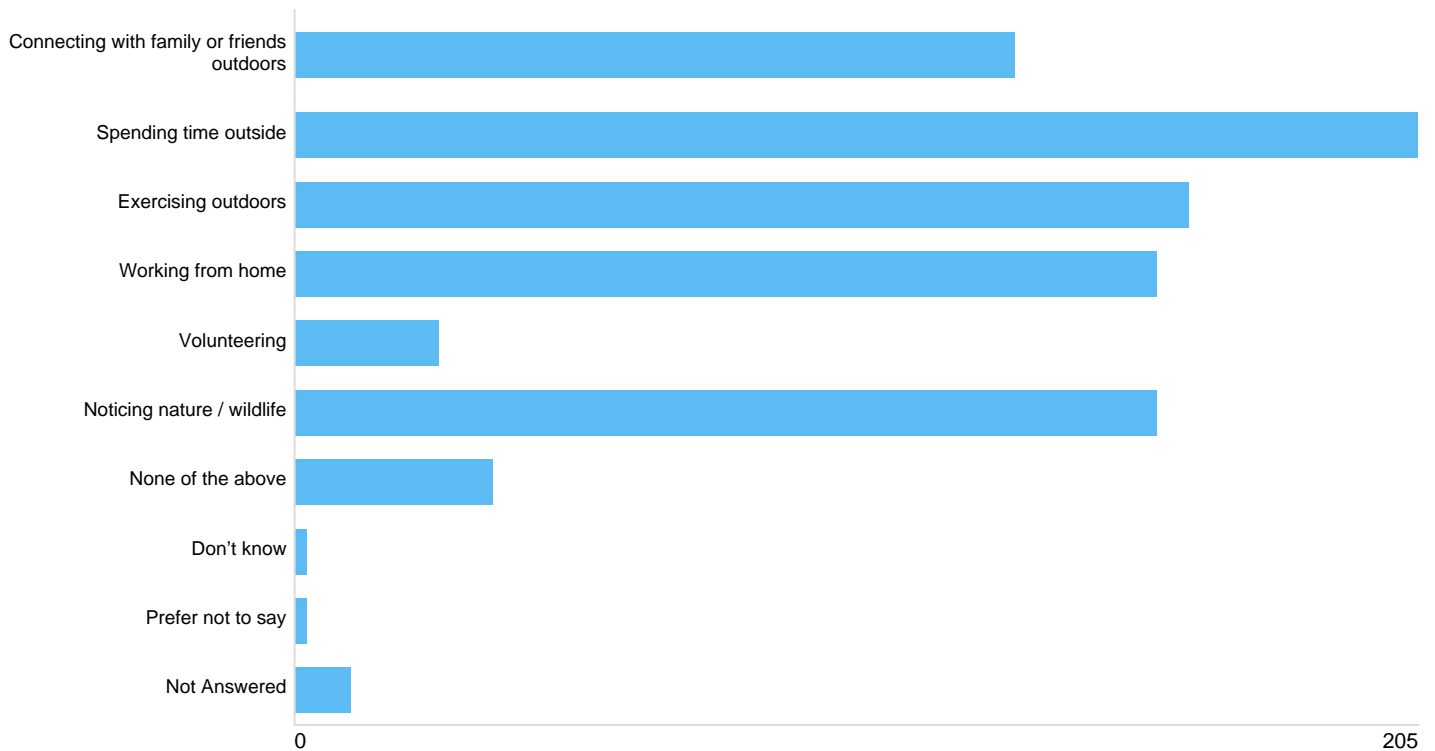

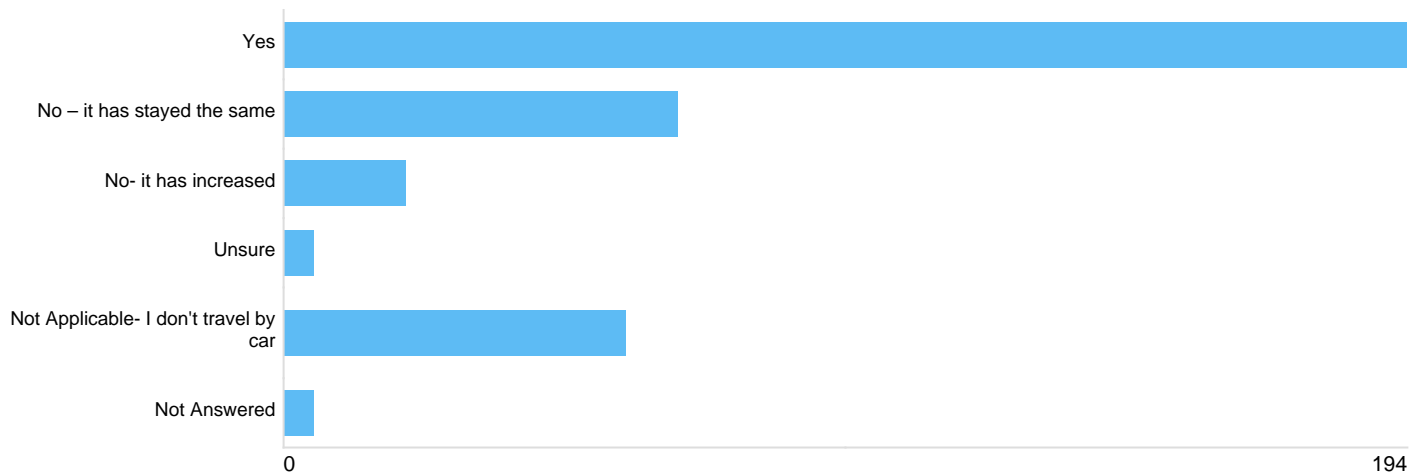

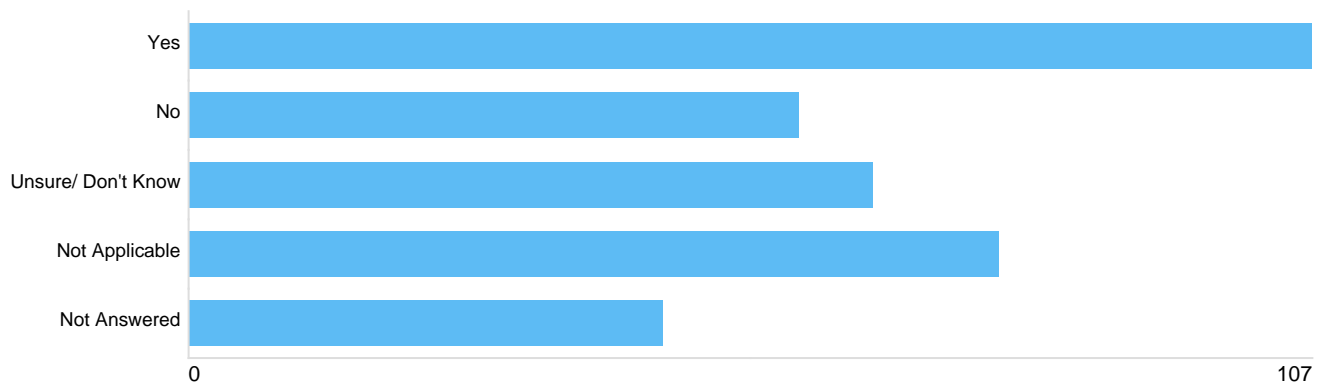
