**Alexandra Primary School – Consultation on Proposed “School Streets”  
Scheme – Access restriction in Denbigh Road and Tiverton Road and  
associated Red Route No Stopping restrictions.**

In recent years, the council has stepped up its efforts to tackle problems associated with traffic around schools at drop-off and pick-up times, notably road safety concerns, poor air quality, and inconvenience to residents.

Following successful implementations of School Street schemes in other parts of the borough, and discussions with Alexandra Primary School and local councillors, we are now consulting on a proposal to implement a School Streets scheme in your area.

The access restriction will cover the length of Denbigh Road and part of Tiverton Road (between its junction with Denbigh Road and Ellington Road) and will operate between **Mon-Fri, 8.15-9.15am and 2.45-3.45pm, during school term time**. There will be exemptions for those who live within the zone and their visitors, blue badge holders, easily recognisable delivery vehicles (e.g. supermarket lorries), or school staff.

To compliment the school street restriction, and prevent obstructive parking on the neighbouring main road, Kingsley Road and its junction with Denbigh Road, we also propose to introduce Double red line No Stopping “At Any Time red” route restrictions as follows:

- At the junction of Kingsley Road and Denbigh Road.
- Outside Nos. 135 – 139 Kingsley Road.

Red Route controls place strict limitations on parking, preventing not only waiting and loading, but stopping also. They can be enforced by CCTV, unlike most other parking restrictions such as yellow lines.

Both the school street and red route restrictions will be enforced by the Council through the use of CCTV, which could be either mobile or fixed cameras.

Full details of this proposal, including a plan (also enclosed here) and a list of FAQs (Frequently Asked Questions) on School Streets, are available on the Hounslow consultation website, along with a short survey we would encourage you to complete to let us know your views on the proposal.
